# 1. COUNTRY HIGHLIGHTS


More than eight in ten respondents in Italy consider climate change to be a 'very serious' problem (81%, EU average 74%). However, fewer than one in ten see it as the single most serious problem facing the world (7%, EU average 12%).


Over one-third say they have taken personal action to fight climate change in the past six months (34%, EU average 49%). However, when given specific examples this rises to 89%, suggesting that many do not associate certain actions with tackling climate change.

- · Nearly seven in ten of those surveyed in Italy say they try to reduce waste and regularly separate it for recycling (69%, EU average 71%).
- Over one-third try to buy seasonal and locally produced food whenever possible (37%, EU average 41%).
- · Compared to the EU average (26%), a relatively small proportion of respondents regularly use environmentallyfriendly alternatives to their private car (13%).

Respondents in Italy are more likely than the EU average to agree that reducing fossil fuel imports from third countries can benefit the EU economically (75%, EU average 65%). However, they are less likely to agree that the EU can benefit economically from promoting its expertise in clean technologies to countries outside the EU (69%, EU average 77%).






